NASA Astronaut

Dr. Kavandi is a veteran of three space flights, serving as a mission specialist on STS-91 in 1998, STS-99 in 2000, and STS-104 in 2001. Dr. Kavandi has logged more than 33 days in space, traveling more than 13.1 million miles in 535 Earth orbits.

Born in Springfield, Missouri,

Dr. Kavandi earned a Bachelor of Science degree in chemistry from Missouri Southern State College in Joplin, a Master of Science degree in chemistry from the University of Missouri in Rolla, and her Doctorate in analytical chemistry from the University of Washington in Seattle.

She currently serves as the Deputy Director at the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's Glenn Research Center.
