POOL SAFETY RULES

- Swimming is permitted during staffed hours only. Violators will be prosecuted.
- Entry is only permitted to valid pool pass holders or patrons who purchase a daily admission.
- Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Toddlers must be directly supervised, or within arm's reach, by adult or care giver at all times.
- All patrons are required to take a cleansing shower before using the pool.
- Any child not potty trained must wear a water-resistant swim diaper.
- Any person with an obvious infectious wound is not permitted to use the swimming pool.
- Any person suspected of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol are prohibited from entering the pool area.
- Floatation devices of all types are prohibited.
- Bathers must wear proper swim attire. Street clothes, athletic clothing, shorts, and t-shirts are not permitted to be worn in the water.
- Bottles, glassware, or other hazardous objects are not permitted inside the pool fence area.
- No running, pushing, wrestling or rough play allowed. No hanging on the ropes or lane lines.
- No foul language. This is a family friendly facility.
- The City is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please secure your valuable items in a locker or your vehicle.
- Pets are not permitted.
- Spitting, urinating, blowing the nose, spouting water, or depositing foreign matter into the pool is prohibited.
- Management has the right to ask any patron to leave for non-compliance of rules or unruly behavior.
- Use of pool is prohibited during severe weather conditions, i.e., electrical storms, tornados, etc.
- Diving is prohibited off the deck into shallow areas of the pool.
- No smoking or vaping in or around the pool deck area.
