Come with us to the Laurel Highlands and see the award winning Frank Lloyd Wright masterpieces, Fallingwater and Kentucky Knob. Each home is different, although you will see “Wright-touches” throughout. Excellent docents provide insight into the architect, the owners, and the homes themselves. Fallingwater was designed for the Kaufmann family in 1936. The house is dramatically cantilevered over a mountain waterfall. It is considered the most important example of modern architecture in the world. Kentucky Knob rises from a mountainside high above the Youghiogheny River gorge. This extraordinary home, built of native stone and tidewater cypress, is set amidst natural woodlands and surrounded by contemporary sculpture and historic artifacts. Lunch is included.
