Mentor Avenue Construction Notice:

The City would like to inform residents and businesses that the resurfacing of **Mentor Avenue from approximately 500 feet west of Hopkins Road to the Painesville Township Line** is scheduled to begin on **August 24, 2026**.

The majority of this work will take place at night (8 p.m. to 6 a.m.).

This project will be completed over a two-month duration. During construction, **one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction**. Construction is expected to be completed by the **end of October 2026**; the schedule and construction are weather dependent.

Project Improvements Include:

- Full-depth pavement repairs
- Asphalt resurfacing
- Curb repairs and Utility Castings Adjustments
- New traffic signal radar detection installations

Construction Overview:

- Phase 1 – Contractor will be installing new radar detection at each signalized intersection.
- Phase 2 – Miscellaneous full depth pavement repairs followed by removal of the existing surface pavement (**night work**).
- Phase 3 – Intermediate asphalt will be placed, with concrete casting repairs, curb repairs, and any additional pavement repairs (**night work**).
- Phase 4 – Surface asphalt will be placed, and new pavement markings will be applied (**night work**).

Message boards will be placed along Mentor Avenue to provide updates on traffic pattern changes throughout construction. Updates will also be posted on the City's website.

We ask that drivers **use caution, follow posted signs, and allow extra travel time** when traveling through the work zone.
