Colonial Williamsburg Monday - Thursday, October 8-11, 2012

Colonial Williamsburg is the world's leading living history museum – the restored 18th century capital of Britain's largest, wealthiest and most populous outpost in the New World. □In Colonial Williamsburg's 301-acre historic area stand some 500 restored, reconstructed and historically furnished public buildings, homes, stores and taverns. Costumed interpreters tell the stories of the men and women of the 18th century city – black, white and Native American, slave, indentured and free – and the challenges they faced. In this historic place, they help the future learn from the past. Your admission pass entitles you to complete access to explore Colonial Williamsburg's recreated and restored buildings, sites and exhibits. Engage a working carpenter in a discussion about period house construction methods, stop in at the apothecary to learn about 18th century remedies, explore the Governor's Palace and Gardens...at every turn, meet historical interpreters and character actors who will regale them with the expertise of scholars and the flair of performers. Visit Colonial Williamsburg and step back more than 220 years to the eve of the American Revolution. Additional highlights include the Capitol, DeWitt Wallace Decorative Arts Museum, Abby Aldrich Rockefeller Folk Art Center, Bassett Hall. Your tour also includes historic Jamestown & Shenandoah Museum.
