### **First Consolidated Plan Meeting**

The first Consolidated Plan public meeting will be held on Wednesday, **February 16, 2022** from 4:00 PM – 5:00 PM at City Hall in the council chambers on the third floor of 8500 Civic Center Boulevard. This meeting will solicit citizen comments for the 2022-2026 Consolidated Plan and address any questions or concerns regarding the Consolidated Plan.

### **Second Consolidated Plan Meeting**

The second Consolidated Plan public meeting will be held on Wednesday, **April 20, 2022** from 4:00 PM – 5:00 PM at City Hall in the council chambers on the third floor of 8500 Civic Center Boulevard. This meeting will include the announcement of the FY 2022 CDBG City of Mentor allocation; how to access the FY 2022 City of Mentor CDBG Application; and solicit comments for the five-year 2022-2026 Consolidated Plan.

### **Third Consolidated Plan Meeting**

The third Consolidated Plan public meeting will be held on Wednesday, **June 22, 2022** from 4:00 PM – 5:00 PM at City Hall in the council chambers on the third floor of 8500 Civic Center Boulevard. This meeting will include the announcement of the FY 2022 City of Mentor CDBG proposed awards; solicit public comments regarding those awards; and solicit final comments regarding the Consolidated Plan.
