Concept and Theme

Transform a fiberglass book bench into a captivating piece of art while capturing the essence of storytelling!

These one-of-a-kind story book benches will be placed outdoors at Springbrook Gardens Park June through August 2025 for the enjoyment of the public.

By bringing your creative vision to life, the fiberglass book bench will be a delightful addition to the park and serve as a testament to the power of imagination and storytelling.



Suggested Design Elements

- **Storybook Characters**: Choose a book from the PBS Great American Read 100 book list (attached). Iconic characters from beloved books could be subtly integrated into the design, peeking out from the pages of the bench.
- Literary Quotes: Quotes could be included along the edges of the bench.
- **Vibrant Colors**: Adorn the book benches with a palette of bright and inviting colors to attract attention and evoke curiosity.
- **Sealing and Finishing**: A protective sealant will be provided to the artist that once applied will maintain the integrity of the artwork, protecting it from the elements and ensuring longevity.

Benefits of Participation

- **Showcase Talent**: Displaying artwork at such a prominent location provides an excellent platform to showcase the artist's skills.
- **Increased Exposure**: Springbrook Gardens Park is among the most popular parks in our system which will result in high visibility of the selected pieces.
- Media and Social Media Attention: The project will receive coverage in local media, enhancing the artist's profile and reaching new audiences through social media platforms.
- **Networking Opportunities**: The gala book bench auction on August 20, 2025, offers a chance to connect with other artists, art enthusiasts, and potential patrons.

How to Apply

- Five applications will be chosen for production.
- Complete and submit application form along with \$40.00 nonrefundable application fee, proposed design, resumes, and work samples.
- Please complete your proposed designs in full color using the provided templates. Please do not submit designs larger than a standard 8.5"x 11" piece of paper.
- Your application must be accompanied with a resume, and/or printed samples of your work.
- Submissions open to artists 18 and older who reside in Lake County, Ohio.
- All submissions must be received by Monday, March 17, 2025 at 4:00 PM.


Artist Application Packet

Criteria

- Originality of design concept (must be your own design).
- Submissions may not be exact replicas of existing book cover art. It is forbidden to duplicate copywritten material.
- Clarity of design that clearly depicts book choice.
- Design must reflect imagery that is appropriate for all audiences.
- Designs that are religious, political, or sexual, in nature will not be accepted. Corporate logos and advertising are not permitted.
- The selection committee reserves the sole discretion to accept, or reject, any design.
- Designs cannot be changed from the initial proposal; if the Artist wishes to make changes, a new design specification must be submitted and approved.
- All submitted designs will be judged by members of the Community Arts Commission along with professional artists.
- Application fees are NOT refundable.
- Only 5 application submissions will be chosen for production. Selected artists will be notified of acceptance.
- Artists must meet all contractual obligations and adhere to the project timeline.
- Artists must send progress photos on a weekly basis to (potentially) be used in advertising.
- Artists must supply their own materials and paints.
- Selected artists will receive detailed instructions for the pickup and delivery of the book benches.
- Book benches measure 48" x 38" x 38" and weigh a total of 180 lbs. Primer white fiberglass laminated book with a permanent powder coated white steel plate base measuring 48" x 20" x .25".
- Artists will be given a gallon of sealant to apply to bench prior to submitting the final project.
- Book benches will be placed outdoors at Springbrook Gardens Park from June through August 2025.
- Artists should consider the weather and other elements, including sun, rain, wind, and dirt.
- Artists will receive a preliminary payment of \$100.00 for production materials. An additional \$400 will be paid upon delivery and approval of the finished sculpture.

Important Dates

- Deadline for submission is Monday, March 17, 2025 at 4:00pm
- Selected artists will be notified on or before March 28, 2025.
- Artists must pick up their bench from the Wildwood Cultural Center between March 31 and April 4, 2025.
- Artists must deliver completed benches on May 12, 2025, to Springbrook Gardens Park, 6776 Heisley Road, Mentor, OH 44060.
- Story Book Bench Project Gala will be held from 7:00 to 9:00pm on August 20, 2025, at Springbrook Gardens Park.










Front View
