





#### **Confirmations and Cancellations**

A receipt and/or course confirmation will be emailed to you following registration. If a course is canceled by the City of Mentor, you will be notified by phone or email. If the City cancels a course, we welcome you to transfer to another class within the same season, or receive a full refund. It takes two to three weeks to process a refund check. Credit card payees will receive credit on their account within a few days.

#### **Course Refunds**

Please choose your classes carefully. Once you have registered for a course, there will be no full refunds unless the City of Mentor cancels a class. There is a \$10 administrative fee for classes canceled by the customer up to one week before the class begins. Participants may transfer the full course amount to another trip/class/program within the same season to avoid the administrative fee. Students assume risk of change in personal affairs or health.

#### **Camp Refunds**
