302.1 General: All buildings and structures shall be classified with respect to use in one of the use groups listed below.

Assembly (see Section 303.0) 1. Use Group A 2. Use Group B Business (see Section 304.0) 3. Use Group E Educational (see Section 305.0) 4. Use Group F Factory & Industrial (see Section 306.0) 5. Use Group H High hazard (see Section 307.0) 6. Use Group I Institutional (see Section 308.0) 7. Use Group M Mercantile (see Section 309.0) 8. Use Group R Residential (see Section 310.0) 9. Use Group S Storage (see Section 311.0) 10. Use Group U Utility & miscellaneous (see Section 312.0)

303.1 Use Group A-1, Theaters: This use group shall include all theaters, or similar uses usually with fixed seating, for viewing the performing arts.

Use Group A-2, structures: This use group shall include all buildings and places of public assembly, designed for use as dance halls, night clubs, restaurants, and banquet halls

Use Group A-3 structures: including art galleries, exhibition halls, museums, lecture halls, libraries, courtrooms, churches and other similar religious uses, and recreation centers; and buildings designed for other similar assembly purposes including passenger terminals.

Use Group A-4 structures: This use group shall include all indoor sport facilities with spectator seating, including arenas, skating rinks, swimming pools, tennis courts and similar purposes.

Use Group A-5 structures: This use group shall include all facilities for viewing outdoor sport facilities including amusement park structures and bleachers.

304.1 USE GROUP B BUSINESS USES

- 305.1 Use Group E: All buildings and structures, or parts thereof, other than those used for business training or vocational training, shall be classified in use Group E which are used by more than five persons at one time for educational purposes.
- 305.2 Day-care facilities: Use Group E or I-4
- 306.1 Use Group F-1: Factory and industrial uses which are not otherwise classified as low hazard Use Group F-2, shall be classified as moderated hazard factory and industrial. Use Group F-1.
- 307.1 Use Group H: All buildings and structures, or parts thereof, shall be classified in Use Group H which are used for the manufacturing, processing, generation or storage of corrosive, highly toxic, highly combustible, flammable or explosive materials that constitute a high fire or explosion hazard, including hose combustible fibers, dust and unstable materials.
- 308.1 Use Group I: All buildings and structures, or parts thereof, shall be classified in use Group I in which people suffering from physical limitations because of health or age are harbored for medical or other care or treatment, in which people are detained for penal or correction purposes, or in which the liberty of the inmates is restricted.
- 309.1 Use Group M: All buildings and structures or parts thereof, shall be classified in use Group M which are used for display and sales purpose involving stocks of goods, wares or merchandise incidental to such purposes and accessible to the public; including, among others, retail stores, motor fuel service stations, shops and salesrooms and in control areas that do not exceed the limits in Table 414.2.4(1), otherwise the use shall comply with the requirements for Use Group H.

310.1 General: All buildings and structures, or parts thereof, shall be classified In Use Group R in which families or households live, or in which sleeping accommodations are provided for individuals with or without dining facilities, excluding those that are classified as institutional buildings.

311.1 General: All buildings and structures, or parts thereof, shall be classified in Use Group S which are used primarily for the storage of goods, wares or merchandise, except those of Use Group H that involve highly combustible or explosive products or materials; including, among others, warehouses, storehouse and freight depots.
