2020 PROPOSED PROJECTS**

The City of Mentor City Council members announces the proposed projects to be funded with the FY2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) allocation in the amount of \$160,491 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). A public meeting will be held on July 22, 2020 for the purpose of seeking community input and comments regarding the FY 2020 Action Plan budget. Comments will be received until August 7, 2020.

FY2020 PUBLIC SERVICES: \$21,640 (limited to 15% of the total grant allocation)

Activity 1: Lifeline 2-1-1 Call Center: \$5,000
Purpose: To provide funding for the operation of a call center for persons in crisis situations.

Activity 2: Lake County Free Clinic (Dental): \$2,000
Purpose: To provide funds for dental clinic services for low- to moderate-income persons.

Activity 3: Lake County Free Clinic (Medical): \$4,000
Purpose: To provide funds for medical clinic services for low- to moderate-income persons.

Activity 4: Mentor Special Elders Program: \$6,140
Purpose: To provide funds for the operation of programs designed to assist persons 80+ y/o.

Activity 5: The Ecumenical Shelter Network of Lake County, Project Hope: \$4,500
Purpose: To provide funds for staff costs for the operation of a homeless shelter.

FY2020 PROJECTS: \$106,753

Activity 6: Forbes House: \$5,000
Purpose: To provide funding for building acquisition for a domestic violence shelter.

Activity 7: Western Reserve Community Development Corporation: \$65,000
Purpose: To provide funding for the Single-Family Housing Rehabilitation program.

Activity 8: Mentor Economic Assistance Corporation (MEACO): \$10,000
Purpose: To provide funding for a small business revolving loan program.

Activity 9: ADA Sidewalk Enhancements: \$26,753
Purpose: To provide funding for the construction of sidewalk ramps to improve accessibility.

FY2020 ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIVITIES: \$32,098 (limited to 20% of total grant allocation)

Activity 10: Fair Housing Resource Center: \$10,000
Purpose: To provide funding for fair housing services provided to the City of Mentor and residents.

Activity 11: Program Administration: \$22,098
Purpose: To provide funds for the administration of the CDBG program.

PUBLIC MEETING - The City of Mentor will hold a public meeting on July 22, 2020 for the purpose of receiving public input and comments regarding the use of the FY2020 CDBG funds prior to submitting the FY2020 Action Plan to HUD.
