DAY ONE WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2011

Today we will travel by deluxe motorcoach to St. Ignace, located in the upper peninsula of Michigan. Breakfast and lunch stops on your own will be made. We will check into **KEWADIN CASINO & HOTEL** for a two-night stay. You are on your own to enjoy the 24-hour gaming available in the casino.

DAY TWO THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 15, 2011

A buffet breakfast is included before we depart for a day on **Mackinac Island**. We will board the ferry for the 16-minute ride to the island. A **horse drawn carriage** will be waiting to tour us through the downtown area and up to the park. From there we will board larger carriages for a narrated tour through the national park. Mackinac Island National Park was our second park, established three years after Yellowstone. Lunch is included at **The Grand Hotel**, setting for the movie *Somewhere In Time*. After lunch you will have plenty of free time to enjoy the shops of Mackinac Island. You may want to rent bicycles and explore the island. We will take the ferry back to St. Ignace and have the evening free to enjoy the casino. **(B, L)**

DAY THREE FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2011

After the buffet breakfast we will depart for **Frankenmuth**. A stop will be made at **The Cross In The Woods**. Upon arrival in **Frankenmuth** enjoy the shops and restaurants that line the streets. The **Oktoberfest** will be going on so there will be plenty to do. We will check into the **Bavarian Inn Lodge** in the late afternoon to freshen up before our guided tour. Dinner is included this evening. **(B, D)**

DAY FOUR SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2011

Breakfast is included this morning. Today you will have time to enjoy the **Oktoberfest** and well as a stop at **Bronner's Christmas Store**. We will depart for home mid afternoon. **(B)**
