BICYCLE SAFETY

If you ride a bicycle on the road, you must follow the same rules that govern the operation of motor vehicles using Ohio roads. Here are some reminders from the Mentor Police Department

On the Road

- · All traffic laws that apply to motorists apply to cyclists
- Obey all traffic control devices
- Use hand signals to alert motorists of turns and stops
- · Be especially alert for motorists turning right

Ride on the Right

- Always ride in the same direction as traffic
- Ride as near as possible to the right side of the roadway
- Use the designated lane for your intended direction of travel — make left turns from the designated turn lane. Stay to the right within that lane.

Ride Predictably

- · Ride in a straight line
- Don't swerve in the road or between parked cars
- Check for traffic before entering streets or intersections
- Anticipate road hazards and adjust accordingly

Be Visible

- Wear brightly colored clothing that provides contrast and visability
- Use a white front and red rear light in low conditions
- Use a reflector or reflective tape anytime you bike
- Making eye contact with motorists will increase the chance that they have seen you and are aware of you
