Magnolia Plantation and Gardens

Founded in 1676 by the Drayton family, Magnolia Plantation has survived the centuries and witnessed the history of our nation unfold before it from the American Revolution through the Civil War and beyond. It is the oldest public tourist site in the Low Country, and the oldest public gardens in America, opening its doors to visitors in 1870 to view the thousands of beautiful flowers and plants in its famous gardens.

Edmondston-Alston Home of Charleston's (constructed in 1825 and enhanced in 1838) commands a magnificent view of Charleston Harbour. From its piazza, General P. T. Beauregard watched the fierce bombardment of Ft. Sumter on April 12, 1961, signalling the start of the Civil War.

Historic carriage tour of Charleston, SC

Rhett Home - This is perhaps the most remarkable home on Charleston's downtown waterfront. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, the Aiken-Rhett House is a revealing architectural portrait of the antebellum South. It was owned at one time by wealthy planter and former South Carolina governor William Aiken.
