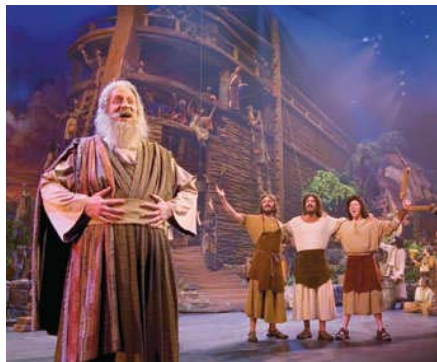


# "Noah" at the Millennium Theatre in Lancaster, PA Plus Gettysburg, Pennsylvania
