Job Title: Full-Time Police Officer Date Posted: March 11, 2020

Department: Police Department Annual Salary: \$58,968.26 to \$82,717.96

Work Description: Under general supervision, a Police Officer patrols a designated area, enforcing State and City laws and maintaining order. A Police Officer answers calls when a crime is suspected, or an emergency exists and takes such actions as are necessary to prevent crime, to apprehend criminals, to maintain safety, and to assist citizens in a wide range of emergency and non-emergency situations. A Police Officer's duties may include assignments to uniformed patrol, traffic work, warrant enforcement or other specialized departmental activity. Work involves an element of personal danger in the pursuit of duties.

Qualification Requirements: High School diploma or equivalent. Must be at least 20-years old at time of application and 21-years old at time of appointment. No person is eligible for an original appointment as a Mentor Police Officer on or after their thirty-sixth (36th) birthday. Must have a valid driver's license. Must successfully complete required police training and achieve Basic Training Certification.

You must submit an application to participate in the Written Exam and you must take the Written Exam to be considered for the Eligibility List for possible appointment. Applications will be accepted in-person at the Civil Service Commission in the City Manager's Office, 3rd Floor, 8500 Civic Center Blvd., Mentor from March 23 – April 3, 2020 from 8:30 am – 4:30 pm, Weekdays Only. Application packets are also available online to print at www.cityofmentor.com. See FACT SHEET for detailed information regarding submission.

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FULL-TIME POLICE OFFICER Entrance Examination 2020 FACT SHEET

Applications for the Written Exam* for Police Officer will be accepted between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm, beginning Monday, March 23 through Friday, April 3, 2020. There is a \$20 filing fee (cash or money order only) to be paid when application is submitted (no personal checks, debit or credit cards). If mailing the application, be sure to include the \$20 filing fee, as well as <u>copies</u> of proof for extra credit points. Applications <u>postmarked by Friday, April 3, 2020</u> will be accepted. Mailed applications will be date/time stamped by the Recording Secretary when received. Date and time that an application is received is used as a tie-breaker to determine final ranking on the Eligibility List per City Code. Candidates must be at least 20-years old at time of application and at least 21-years old at time of original appointment/hire by the City; the City does not entertain direct transfers from other cities based on experience. "No person is eligible to receive an original appointment on or after the person's 36th birthday"; this is in accordance with the Mentor Codified Ord. 159.05.

*Written Exam will be administered on Saturday, April 18, 2020 at Mentor High School. Registration will begin at 8:15 am; the test will begin promptly at 9:00 am. Ramsey & Associates will administer the test; there will not be a review period of the exam and there is no study material. A picture ID/Driver's License must be presented upon check-in at the Written Exam.

<u>Physical Agility Examination</u> is administered periodically through the Tri-C Program. To be processed for possible appointment/hire, you <u>must</u> have a <u>valid</u> Tri-C physical agility certificate at time of appointment (<u>not more than 12-months old</u>). Cost for this is at the applicant's own expense. This certificate is <u>NOT</u> required to take the Written Exam.

<u>Other Requirements</u>: You must participate in the following to an acceptable level to be eligible to be appointed to the position of Police Officer: Written Examination, Tri-C Physical Agility Test, Background Investigation, Polygraph Examination, Medical Examination, Psychological Test, Drug Screening and Oral interview. You must be a U.S. Citizen at time of appointment.

Extra Points: Applicants who receive a passing grade of at least 70% on the Written Exam can earn an additional two (2) points for each of the following only if proper documentation is provided by the end of the registration period at 4:30 p.m on April 3, 2020, although it is preferred you provide all documentation at time of application:

- Applicants who have successfully completed an Ohio Police Academy AND hold a current Ohio Police Certification as defined by OPOTC not more than 12-months old. Recently graduated students may submit a copy of a valid letter of completion not more than 12-months old with signatures from the State of Ohio Attorney General as proof. Currently employed police officers may submit a copy of their Officer ID as proof; your employment will be verified;
- 2) Applicants with proof of Honorable Discharge (Long Form DD214, pg. 2 or Member Copy 4 with signatures), or a Letter of Proof signed by your Commanding Officer stating your "Current Active Duty Service in Good Standing"; and
- 3) Applicants with a Certificate of Associate degree or higher from an accredited university or college, or who have accumulated class credits equivalent to two complete years (60 credit hours) AND are currently enrolled in pursuit of a 4-year degreed program at an accredited university or college as defined by the U.S. Department of Education. Internet printed transcripts MUST show applicant's name, degree name and total credit hours to qualify. Sealed transcripts are also acceptable proof.
