LAKE COUNTY STUDENT SHOWCASE

Wildwood Cultural Center and the City of Mentor Community Arts Commission welcome all Lake County student artists to partake in annual Student Showcase. This exhibit features student artists in grades 6th through 12th who reside in Lake County.

Awards will be given out to selected artists to further their future in the ARTS!

Artwork can be entered by filling out the attached entry form and submitting it to the Mentor Municipal Center, 8500 Civic Center Blvd. All artwork will be on display for public viewing at the Mentor Municipal Center during the times listed below.

ART DROP OFF: March 29, 3-6 pm

RECEPTION: April 4, 7—8:30 p.m. at Mentor Municipal Center, 8500 Civic Center Blvd.,

ART ON DISPLAY: April 4th - April 26th, Monday - Friday, 9 a.m. to 5p.m.

ART PICK UP: April 29th, 3-6 p.m.

Exhibit Rules & Guidelines:

- The entry fee for this exhibit is FREE. One entry per Lake County student.
- Featured artwork must be completed by a Lake County student in 6th through 12th grade.
- All artwork must have been completed in the past year.
- Artwork media are accepted in the following categories: Watercolor, Oil & Acrylic, Photography, Drawing (pastel, charcoal, pencil, ink), Mixed Media, Digital Print & 3D (sculptures/glass/pottery/wood/textiles/metals/jewelry).
- All artwork must have a completed entry tag (provided on the entry form) secured to the upper right corner of its reverse side and must include the exhibitor's name, address, phone number, title of entry, price or NFS (not for sale) listing, value, and media type.
- The maximum size for artwork will be 30 inches by 40 inches, including framing. The maximum size for 3D is 12 inches high by 15 inches wide or deep. All entries must be appropriately mounted and framed. If framed, it must be complete with screw eyes and wire across the back for hanging. Artwork that does not comply with these show standards will not be accepted.
- If you are dropping off artwork as an instructor for students, please drop off multiple artwork all at once. An [unveiled] representative will be on site to assist you if you have any questions.
- The following types of media will not be accepted (including but not limited to): nudes, political in nature, crocheting, knitting, needlework, decoupage, dough art, floral displays, commercially produced or manufactured items, and resale of greenware products. The City of Mentor reserves the right to decline any artwork that is deemed inappropriate for public viewing.
- If an art piece in exhibit is purchased during the showcase, the City of Mentor Community Arts Commission will receive 10% of the purchase price.
- Unless an objection is indicated, permission to photograph for publicity is assumed.
- All entries must be signed out and picked up at the Mentor Municipal Center on Monday, April 29th, between 3 and 6 p.m. Wildwood Cultural Center is not responsible for entries not picked up on the above date!
